**Active Travel Challenge Launch Assembly**

On Monday, you would have received an email with information about the 'Active Travel Challenge' which starts on Monday 15th January. This is a pupil-led challenge which enables children to self-report how they get to school every day. If they travel actively (walk/wheel, cycle, scoot or park and stride) at least once a week for a month, they get rewarded with a badge at the end of that month.

An assembly was held this week by Jim Shaw who runs the challenge, and the children were really excited about the scheme and the prospect of earning badges and starting their day with exercise.

## Operation Encompass Information

Our school is part of Operation Encompass which is a national scheme that operates jointly between schools and police forces. Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced domestic abuse.

As a school we have ensured that a member of our staff, (Designated Safeguarding Lead) known as a Key Adult, has been trained in the Operation Encompass procedures allowing us to then use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to support the child/ren in our care.

The Domestic Abuse Act 2021 identifies children who experience domestic abuse as victims of domestic abuse in their own right.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved. Please do not hesitate to ask if you have any queries.

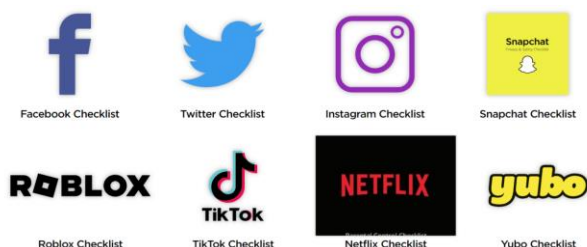
