**Sheffield Support Dogs**

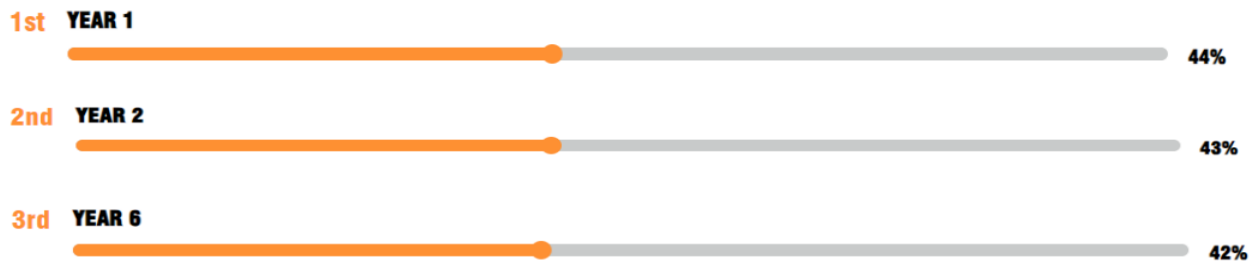
