Active Travel Challenge

This year, Coit is participating in an exciting initiative to encourage more children and their families to walk to school. The Active Travel Challenge is delivered by Living Streets, a charity which wants as many children as possible to experience the benefits of walking to school.

This pupil-led challenge allows children to self-report how they get to school every day. If they travel actively (walk/wheel, cycle, scoot or park and stride) at least once a week for a month, they get rewarded with a badge at the end of that month.

The challenge will start on Monday 15th January and a letter with more information will follow in the new year.
