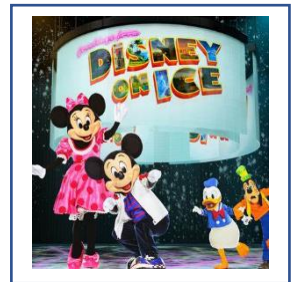
### Disney on Ice Competition
