### Anti-Bullying Week 11<sup>th</sup> Nov-15<sup>th</sup> Nov

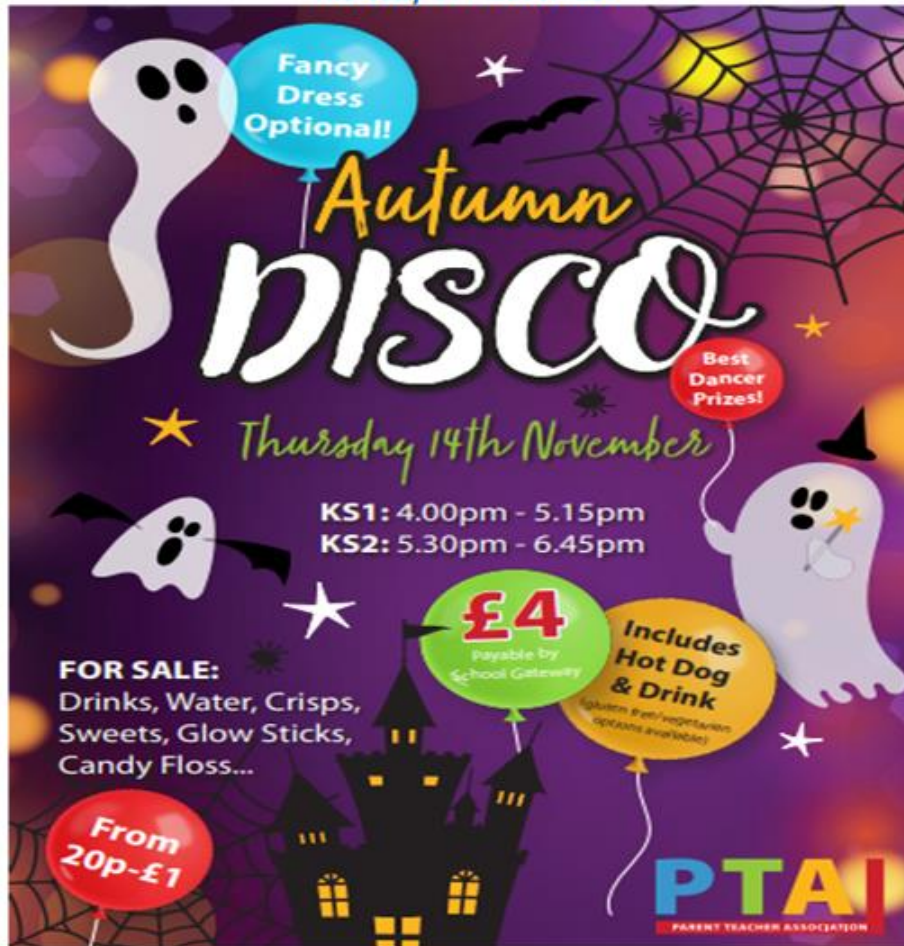
To kick-start Anti-Bullying Week, the children can wear odd socks on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November to celebrate that we are all different and unique.
