Age: there is no minimum age or maximum age for this session it's all about the rider's ability. Our Access sport cycling coaches will be there to support riders to get pedalling. We focus on building confidence and skills such as pedalling unaided, breaking and cornering. For this session we ask you to bring your own bike if you can as we only have limited bikes of different sizes, so if you can bring your own and our coach will give it a quick safety check. We provided all safety wear if needed (helmet, arm pads, knee pads and gloves)
