Friday 5th December



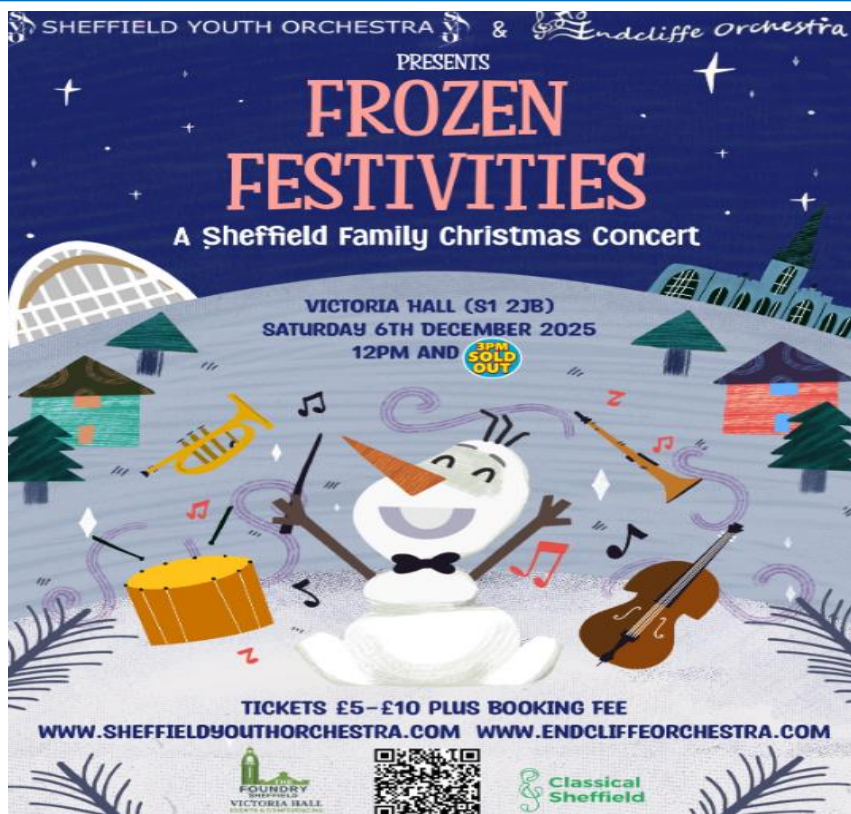
