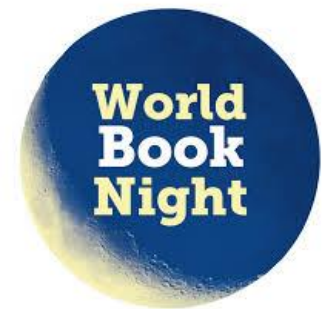


World Book Night
